### Controls and status lights



A portable speakerphone with corded connectivity.

Djj	Press to interact with Microsoft Teams (Teams model only, desktop application required)
	Volume down
J.J.J.	Mute / Hold
<\+	Volume up
S	Call
)  -	LED bar

### LEDs

LED bar	What lights mean
Flashing green	Incoming call
Solid green	In a call
Solid red	Mute active
Flashing red	Call on hold

**NOTE** LEDs do not illuminate in standby mode.

### Setup

### Corded setup

Connect the USB cable from the speakerphone to the USB port on your computer. **NOTE** *Your speakerphone has a USB-A to USB-C adapter for easy connection to either type of port.* 



#### Load software

Download Poly Lens App to get the most out of your device. Some softphones require the installation of Poly software to enable device call control (answer/end and mute) functionality. Download: poly.com/software.

# Basics



Power		Plug the USB cable into your computer. The LED bar illuminates when powered on. <b>NOTE</b> Your speakerphone has a USB-A to USB-C adapter for easy connection to either type of port.
Answer or end a call		Press the Call $\%$ button to answer or end a call.
Make a call		Dial using your softphone application.
Hold call		Press and hold the Mute $\frac{1}{2}$ button for 2 seconds to hold the call. The LED bar flashes red. To resume call, hold the Mute $\frac{1}{2}$ button for 2 seconds. The LED bar returns to solid green. <b>NOTE</b> The Call $\stackrel{\circ}{\scriptstyle >}$ button is also equipped to hold calls. Press the Call $\stackrel{\circ}{\scriptstyle >}$ button for 2 seconds to hold/resume call.
Volume		Press the Volume up (+) or down (-) buttons to increase or decrease volume.
		Adjust speakerphone microphone volume Place a test softphone call and adjust softphone volume and PC sound volume accordingly.
Mute/Unmute		During an active call, press the Mute $\rlap{P}{\wp}$ button to mute or unmute the microphones. Manage mute settings in Poly Lens App.
Launch Microsoft Teams (Teams model		Your device has a Teams 🗊 button to quickly view and use the Microsoft Teams desktop app. The Teams button pulses when you have a meeting or notification.
oniy)	•	When not on a call, tap the Teams 助 button to view Microsoft Teams app on your computer. When the Teams button LED pulses purple, tap to view your Teams notifications or meeting.
		<b>NOTE</b> Teams model and open Teams desktop application required. Teams mobile application is not supported.
		<b>NOTE</b> If your Teams button is not responsive, ensure your Poly device is the default audio device in Microsoft Teams settings.

	• Teams model is compatible with Microsoft Teams desktop app. Teams mobile app is not supported.
(Teams model only) When I tap the Teams button nothing happens.	• Your device is not set as the default audio input and output device in Microsoft Teams. Change settings in Microsoft Teams.
